The Organize Illinois 2022 Operations Director is a senior position integral to the efficient operations of this statewide program.

In 2022 Illinois faces the biggest election cycle we'll see this decade, with nearly every office on the ballot, from US Senate to state house. This includes a highly competitive gubernatorial race, a battle for the Illinois Supreme Court, and a best-in-the-nation chance to net a new Democratic member of Congress.

We are looking for passionate, experienced, and hardworking individuals who are committed to building the grassroots voter mobilization operation needed to win elections up and down the ballot for Democrats in November 2022.

What Will You Do?

As the Organize Illinois 2022 Operations Director, you will serve as the lead operations strategist, ensuring the operations infrastructure for a statewide coordinated campaign is created and in place to support a large-scale statewide voter contact, protection, and turnout operation. You will oversee the coordinated campaign's budget and lead in the management of program logistics to ensure that all resources are utilized effectively and in compliance with relevant campaign finance laws and internal metrics.

Responsibilities Include:

• Manage the day-to-day logistics and administration for the coordinated campaign by overseeing multiple operations projects including, but not limited to, supplies, supporter housing, offices, equipment and field staff hiring and onboarding logistics

- Support the hiring and onboarding processes of new campaign staff in close coordination with DPI
- Develop and institute operational procedures for coordinated campaign staffers
- Address operations issues and needs from field staff in a timely manner
- Work with the Campaign Director and other team members to ensure that all expenses across the organization are tracked and remain within budget
- Coordinating with vendors to ensure proper allotment of materials are delivered and received at the applicable office level
- Helping to implement the logistics for staff events and trainings
- Other duties as assigned

The ideal candidate will be a highly motivated and passionate promoter of Democratic values with experience coordinating organizational logistics, preferably in a political campaign environment. You are extremely organized and detail oriented. You are comfortable working in a fast paced environment and you strive to create clarity out of ambiguity.

- Previous campaign operations experience preferred, but not required
- Familiarity with campaign compliance procedures campaign finance laws, but not required
- Exceptional organization and time management skills, ability to manage multiple projects at once;
- Highly proficient in Excel/google docs with experience working from shared databases and workbooks.
- Resilient, resourceful, and adaptive to priority shifts and change
- Strong interpersonal skills, customer service mentality, and the ability to communicate effectively with people of different backgrounds;
- A passion for social justice and a commitment to Democratic Party values;
- Ability to work in a fast-paced, high-pressure environment;
- Sense of humor and solutions-oriented attitude;
- Ability to work long and irregular hours in a metric-driven environment;
- Ability to be flexible under pressure and meet tight deadlines;
